In this script we hear the sounds of the 3 men (neutral accents) begin to attack a nameless person on the street, before the announcer asks the listener a question. We're then briefly transported back in to the scene where the identity of the victim is revealed before a strong CTA to help the INAR introduce hate-crime legislation.

SFX: We begin to hear shoving, the sound of 3+ men pushing someone, sniggering in the background.

VO1: Alright lad, where d'ya think you're off to?

SFX: We hear punches being thrown and crying from the victim.

VO2: Haha we've got ya!

VO3: You're done.

SFX: The SFX continue under the ANNCR .

ANCR: Would there be greater urgency for hate-crime legislation in Ireland, if more of us were at risk?

SFX: Further punches and crying.

VO1: Irish-looking (bleep).

ANCR: The Irish Network Against Racism is working to introduce hate-crime legislation in Ireland before

it's too late.
